World Health Organization. Evolved the role into lecturer in disaster medicine and disaster education at university level, designing courses in emergency response and disaster relief. Co-founder of Research Centre in Emergency and Disaster Medicine at the Università del Piemonte Orientale.

In the current role at Università del Piemonte Orientale I am leading the Simulation Centre in Health Science and doing research in the field of simulation-based learning and teaching. I lectured in many national and international scientific congresses and I am author of more than 45 research articles published in peer review journals (see
