Introduction

<u>SESAM</u> - Society for Simulation in Europe's mission is to encourage and support the use of simulation in healthcare for the purpose of training and research. We are not affiliated to any medical or other speciality. Our over 500 members from all over the world have a wide and varied background within healthcare and medical education, with a shared interest and passion in medical simulation.

Whilst the society's main source of income has to date been the increasingly successful Annual Meeting (1,300 attendees in 2024), we wish to expand our offer year-round, providing added opportunity to engage existing and attract new members through forums and online events.

Project Overview

SESAM is seeking proposals from qualified professionals or organisations to provide Executive Director services under contract to the Society. The successful contractor will work under the direction of the Executive Committee to provide strategic leadership and operational management. This is a full-time contract position with the successful candidate playing a central role in providing continuity to the management of the society.

The Executive Director will be responsible for four key areas:

- Drive implementation of SESAM's strategic goals and objectives
- Support policy development and implementation
- Ensure effective risk management and compliance

Operational Excellence

- Oversee day-to-day operations

- Ensure operational efficiency and effectiveness

- Oversee financial planning and sustainability
- Develop and implement fundraising strategies
- Maintain robust financial controls

Stakeholder Management

- Lead member engagement initiatives
- Develop strategic partnerships
- Enhance SESAM's global profile

- Experience in the not-for-profit sector
- Demonstrated knowledge of non-profit governance and management
- Experience in financial and project management
- Strong understanding of association management principles

Contract Terms
