To about what they're doing and what they're producing and what's the future of this innovative ideas. So this is the beginning of the idea of Cezanne. We want to give the opportunity to our Members to have this nest where they can start growing their ideas.

Simulation failed. How can we protect our ideas? How can we boost our ideas? How can we share and probably have the potential to develop?

Together, some of our ideas that we have in the simulation field, so apart from this, I think it's a great opportunity as we have this wide perspective and different colleagues that have experience in different fields to also showcase their innovative ideas.

So that's why we opened the Sezaman showcase process where any delegate can present their idea they can send to cesam elevator pitch video from 2:00 to 3:00 minutes, where they can they can showcase their idea. After this process, we will select the eight most.

Relevant ideas that were submitted and then during the pre conference afternoon. They will have the possibility to showcase this ideas to some experts from industry, from education field, from the research field and from the clinical assimilation field as well in in the Broadway. So what they it's it's going to be something like a Dragon's den, a Shark Tank perspective where they will have the capability to train the speech.

The way they can engage the way they can in in a few minutes.

Just show a proposal, present their idea, and catch everyone's attention about what's what, what they developing and how can they and receive. Also the feedback from this group of and panel of experts about what they developing and how can they probably improve this this idea. So for why I'm am I talking about at this point with with you? Because I think it's very important to have.

Industry in this panel.

Of people that can evaluate the ideas that we would be presented. So we are more than welcome to receive.

Your availability to participate in session and showcase and I am more than welcome to show you this, this opportunity and how can you collaborate in this in this process. According to this process of Sessumin showcase, we will also launch a new awards

that will be related for the three.

That showcases they will have an award that will be supported by Mr Lou Obaddorf and we will have the Lou Opendorf award. That's three of them. We will have the possibility to gain this grant of 2800 euros to support them, to launch and skip developing their ideas through the year and then we will want to engage with this. Three groups where they can have the possibility in the next.

One or two years to show us that the results of the projects that they are developing, so this is the general idea of what is 1009. We are starting as a small ag in this in this incubator in this net. We hope that we can grow this idea in the future years. But I think it's something that is new in our field and I think it's quite important because all of us we have so many ideas that sometimes we are stuck because we don't know. What's the right path to follow and to keep developing this this project?

Voice more. I mean better well known, better known in the.


In the surgical field and also to incorporate different inputs and having you know different minds in, in our scientific community extended group.
